FUNCTION:

1. Responsible for all aspects of food preparation, handling, and clean up and customer service.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS:

1. Reports and is responsible to the Grill Supervisor, ACDP, CDP and Food Services Manager but under the overall authority of the General Manager.

ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND:

1. Founded in 1964, the University of Victoria Students' Society (UVSS) is an incorporated membership based non-profit that is autonomous from the University and provides advocacy, services and events to all undergraduate students at UVic.

DUTIES:

1. Prepare and sell food and beverage items.
2. Provide friendly and efficient customer service.
3. Maintain stock in relevant food service areas and restock area prior to end of shift.
4. Ensure a high standard of cleanliness in food services and customer areas.
5. Adhere to and maintain Public Health Act, Food Premises Regulations.
6. Operate the Point of Sale (POS) system.
7. Notify the appropriate Supervisor of any issues.
8. Ensure proper food portions.
9. Ensure all equipment is used and maintained in a proper and safe manner.
10. Other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

1. Must be an active member in good standing of the University of Victoria Students' Society (registered in undergraduate classes).
2. Valid FOODSAFE Level I certificate.
3. Must be organized and have cash handling experience.
4. Dedicated to a high level of customer service.
5. Must be able to work as part of a team.
6. Must be punctual and reliable.
7. Demonstrated basic knowledge of food preparation skills.
8. Ability to work independently with little supervision.

Preferred:

1. Experience working in a high volume food outlet.
