FUNCTION:

1. Assists in the daily site operations of the community garden, education and outreach.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP:

1. Reports to the CCG Coordinator through the CCG Board of Directors but is under the overall authority of the UVSS Executive Director.

ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND:

- 1. Founded in 1964, the University of Victoria Students' Society (UVSS) is an incorporated membership based non-profit that is autonomous from the University and provides advocacy, services and events to all undergraduate students at UVic.
- 2. The CCG is an organization that provides space to UVic students, faculty, and staff for organic urban agriculture.

DUTIES:

- 1. Assist the CCG Coordinator with garden volunteers, site projects and work parties.
- 2. Assist the CCG Coordinator with the maintenance of communal garden areas.
- 3. Assist the CCG Coordinator with workshops and events.
- 4. Assist the CCG Coordinator with maintenance of infrastructure.
- 5. Provide site tours and volunteer training.
- 6. Assist in managing the care of plants i.e. pruning, harvesting, watering, etc.
- 7. Other related duties as assigned by the CCG Coordinator or UVSS Executive Director.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

- 1. Must be a member in good standing of the University of Victoria Students' Society (a current undergraduate student).
- 2. Minimum one season of organic gardening and/or farming experience.
- 3. Passionate about gardening, food security, and sustainability.
- 4. Demonstrated commitment to fostering positive community atmosphere.
- 5. Able to perform moderate physical labour i.e. lifting up to 40 lbs.
- 6. Able to organize, prioritize and follow through on tasks.
- 7. Able to self-direct and take initiative.
- 8. Excellent written and verbal communication and interpersonal skills.
- 9. Willingness to work flexible days and hours.

Preferred:

- 1. Experience with the CCG or another similar community garden.
- 2. Knowledge of irrigation systems.
