# FUNCTION:

1. To ensure a high level of security in and around licensed areas at all times.

### **ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS:**

- 1. Is responsible to Business Operations Manager through the Beverage Services Managers.
- 2. Reports directly to the supervisor on duty.

# **ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND:**

1. Founded in 1964, the University of Victoria Students' Society (UVSS) is an incorporated membership based non-profit that is autonomous from the University and provides advocacy, services and events to **all undergraduate students** at UVic.

# DUTIES:

- 1. To control the entry of patrons into all licensed areas.
- 2. To check for legal identification, to control problems or potential problems.
- 3. To ensure Liquor Control Act policies are enforced.
- 4. To maintain bag check station and to collect cover charge if necessary.
- 5. When slow periods occur, assist in cleaning tables and bringing in liquor and kegs.
- 6. Responsible for set-up tasks as required.
- 7. Check washrooms and secure all areas at the end of a shift.
- 8. Other related duties as assigned by the Beverage Services Managers or the Business Operations Division Manager.

# **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Must be licensed under the Security Services Act.
- 2. Must have "Serving It Right" certificate.
- 3. One years' experience as a Security Attendant in a busy licensed establishment required.
- 4. Must be nineteen (19) years of age or older.
- 5. Must have completed all training sessions outlined.
- 6. Dedication to a high level of customer level service.
- 7. Must be able to work as part of a team.
- 8. An active member in good standing with the University of Victoria Students' Society will be given priority if they meet all the qualifications.
