DUTIES:

- 1. Prepare and sell food and beverage items.
- 2. Provide friendly and efficient customer service.
- 3. Maintain stock in relevant food service areas and restock area prior to end of shift
- 4. Ensure a high standard of cleanliness in food services and customer areas.
- 5. Adhere to and maintain Public Health Act, Food Premises Regulations.
- 6. Operate the Point of Sale (POS) system.
- 7. Notify the appropriate Supervisor of any issues.
- 8. Ensure proper food portions.
- 9. Ensure all equipment is used and maintained in a proper and safe manner.
- 10. Other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

- 1. Must be an active member in good standing of the University of Victoria Students' Society (registered in undergraduate classes).
- 2. Valid FOODSAFE Level I certificate.
- 3. Must be organized and have cash handling experience.
- 4. Dedicated to a high level of customer service.
- 5. Must be able to work as part of a team.
- 6. Must be punctual and reliable.
- 7. Demonstrated basic knowledge of food preparation skills.
- 8. Ability to work independently with little supervision.

Preferred:

1. Experience working in a high volume food outlet.
