WHEREAS Julia Denley and Emma Levins has nominated themself to be the UVSS undergraduate student representative for the *University of Victoria's Accessibility Committee*.

"Dear UVSS Board Members,

Thank you for considering my nomination for one of the undergraduate representative spots on the new Accessibility Committee. I am both a council member and an executive council member of the SSD. While I am fairly new to the SSD and advocating for accessibility, I have taken initiative to advocate for Uvic students with disabilities in several different ways. First, I have done tabling at various events at the start of the school year such as the Grad student Orientation and Course Union and Clubs' Day at the SUB. Here I spoke to Uvic students with disabilities about the SSD and listened to community members tell me their stories about accessibility at UVIC. I also took the initiative to start a poster campaign with the SSD advocating for people with disabilities who use mobility aids. The aim was to raise awareness around campus about mobility aids and their various uses. This campaign was born out of personal experience using a mobility aid around campus and dealing with stigma, as well as after hearing various members of the SSD community speak about how the stigma surrounding mobility aids was hard for them to deal with. I am committed to advocating for accessibility at Uvic, amplifying disabled students' voices, and making campus more accessible for them.

As a Disabled Queer Uvic student, with multiple chronic illnesses and mental disabilities, I believe I would be a good addition to the new accessibility committee. While at Uvic I have encountered significant ableism and am committed to reducing this ableism and making it easier for disabled students like myself to attend Uvic.

"Dear UVSS Board Members,

Thank you for considering my nomination for one of the undergraduate representative spots on the new Accessibility Committee. I have been in various leadership roles throughout my time at UVic, and am

adept at listening to student feedback, summarizing key concerns, and strongly advocating for necessary changes to support students. In the past, I have been a club executive, a UVSS Campaigns Committee Member, and a Student Mental Health Leader through OSL. I currently sit on the Faculty of Science Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Council and am going into my second year in that role. On this committee, I have advocated for marginalized students and garnered support for developing a training for faculty to better support disabled students; I'll be working on developing that training this fall.

My biggest advocacy role at UVic has been through serving on the Council of the Society for Students with a Disability. I have been a General Member-at-Large, Student Liaison, Interim UVSS Board Representative, and more recently, the Chairperson of the Council. As Student Liaison, I started the Access4All Campaign, which advocates for equitable access to education, primarily by fighting for hybrid course access and through UVic community education about the barriers disabled students face. I presently Co-Chair this campaign. Through my roles with SSD and Access4All, I have also spoken about post-secondary disability advocacy at two panel discussions run by the National Educational Association of Disabled Students. As SSD Chair, I work to ensure we use student funds in a responsible manner that centres the needs of the most impacted and marginalized folks, and I am constantly thinking of ways to make our campus community more accessible to and supportive of disabled folks.

During the 2021-2022 school year, I was one of the student representatives on the committee that was revising the Academic Accommodations and Access for Students with Disabilities Policy. Unfortunately, despite our efforts to stay involved, UVic instead chose to finish the policy without the student representatives' involvement over the summer. We have been told that the new Accessibility Committee is our opportunity for continued involvement. I am extremely keen to continue advocating for disabled students through the work of this new committee.

More personally, I am autistic, queer, and have multiple physical and mental health disabilities. I have encountered significant structural ableism at UVic and care deeply about advocating for others who face barriers in their post-secondary experience here.
